TAKE DOWN YOUR GARAGE SALE SIGNS

Signs posted on City or utility poles advertising your garage or yard sale are illegal. To avoid fines, take the signs down immediately after the event is over. Don't rely on your civic association to do it.

NURSING HOMES WITHOUT WALLS

This program provides health care at home for chronically ill or disabled adults who might otherwise have to enter a nursing home or a health-related facility. NO SPECIAL LEAF COLLECTIONS

The Department of Sanitation will not be making special leaf collections this fall. Leaves should be placed at the curb in non-recycling garbage cans or bags on regular garbage pick up days. This information was provided by 311.

POOPER-SCOOPER LAW FINE INCREASED

The maximum fine for failure to pick up after your dog has been increased to \$250.00. This is the first time since the law went into effect in 1978 that the fine has been raised. Your compliance with the law will help to keep our community clean and green. And may save you money.
